


Identifying icons that we as Pakistanis are encircled by and working with them as popular imagery to elevate the understanding of our own identity and build on the spirit of belonging, is the thought behind the 'B-series' product line at Warehouse. We work with local craft, materials and ideas and try to experiment with what exists. From our mugs, trays, key chains, planters and coasters to our latest new-aged candle stands; we have used the local craft to generate a bright and colorful range of products by adding the much-needed twist. Each of our products have an interesting and unique story and the journey from their pre-existing scrap form to the designer, funky and bright home accessory is amazing. While raising the bar of quality and designing products which forward a sense of belonging, we pride ourselves in going the extra mile by keeping our ideas and products sustainable.

Apart from the B-series product range, Warehouse has also ventured into publications for a cause, launching its very first publication on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of March 2011. A box set collective, titled 'Mein bhi Pakistan hoon' a collaborative project involving 7 very talented young photographers of Pakistan, adamant to present in their captured images the other, softer side of Pakistan. This was initiated solely to uplift spirits in these unfortunate times of distress and was largely appreciated by individuals as well as the CSR Association of Pakistan, leading them to certify the Warehouse team as a body working towards Corporate Social Responsibility.

Other Warehouse publications include the Icon series posters, designed by *Mariam Hussain*, once again representative of elements that we can call our very own.

Warehouse has been exhibiting frequently over the past few months of its conception with art ranging from photography, graphic design and digital art to paintings, prints, miniatures and ceramics.

The studio hosts facilities for project based clientele including fine artists, Architects and Interior Designers, along with gallery exhibitions, in-house and school based Clay workshops for diverse age groups, outdoor events including birthday parties and school

Sadia Salim (FA 1994) studied Design majoring in Ceramics at IVS, Karachi. She has exhibited her work nationally as well as internationally. She was the recipients of 2007 Commonwealth Arts and Crafts Award. Salim has undertaken artist residencies at the Institute of Ceramic Studies, Shigaraki, Japan, Greatmore Studios Cape Town and University of Johannesburg in South Africa. In April 2010, she was invited for a joint residency at Bluecoat Gallery and Liverpool Hope University. She has extensive experience in teaching and also coordinating the Department of Ceramics at Indus Valley School of Art and Architecture. In 2010, she received the Fulbright Scholarship and is currently pursuing Ed.M in Art and Art Education at Columbia University.

After winning his first Design Excellence Award in 2009, *Fawad Suhail Abbasi (AR 2002)* won his second Design Recognition Award from IAP this year for professional excellence. In 2011 he was also elected as the youngest Chairman of IAP, Islamabad Chapter and Member, Architecture, Executive Committee of PCATP. 
# **VISION 2020**
